CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

In seeking to obey the Great Commission of Jesus to "make disciples of all nations . . . teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matt. 28:19–20), the Orthodox Presbyterian Church has established the Committee on Christian Education (CCE) to assist the church. Thank you for your support of the 2025 Thank Offering and yearlong giving to Worldwide Outreach.

Your support helps us to produce *New Horizons*, the monthly magazine of the OPC. The goal of *New Horizons* is to teach faithfully about Christian doctrine and life and to inform readers about OPC ministries. The print edition is distributed free of charge to all OP members and churches.



The CCE also oversees OPC.org, the official website of the OPC, which provides information regarding OP churches, doctrinal resources, and ministry opportunities. It is also home to the online journal *Ordained Servant*.

Your support also allows the CCE to assist in ministerial instruction and training. The CCE helps those aspiring to gospel ministry by holding the OPC Timothy Conference for young men ages sixteen to twenty-one. Since the first conference in 2008, nineteen graduates of the Timothy Conference have been ordained as OPC gospel ministers.

Each year, the committee also assists in cosponsoring summer and yearlong internships for men under care of the presbyteries and for licentiates. The internships provide seminarians with the opportunity to test their gifts in exhorting and serving in local OP congregations. In the last decade, nearly one hundred newly ordained and installed OPC pastors have participated in the internship program.
