## **FOREIGN MISSIONS**

As Israel gave praise and worship when it was delivered out of Egypt and reached the other side of the Red Sea, so it would one day give thanks for its deliverance out of a future exile, according to God's promise in Isaiah 12. So great would be Israel's desire to praise God, it would want to "make known his deeds among the peoples." With an even greater sense than Israel of the spiritual reality of our deliverance and with hearts full of gratitude for Jesus who has covered us from the wrath of God and become our strength, our song, and our salvation, we also want to make known his deeds among the peoples.
